Community study calls for creative thinking during covid

BRITSTOWN — The Foundation for Alcohol Related Research (FARR) have set up offices in Britstown, a small farming community in the Northern Cape and completed an in-depth study and community survey, which will pave the way for community intervention and support.

The study has shown that knowledge needs to be instilled within the Britstown community members to decrease alcohol usage stigma if the affected community members are going to get the support required. The study has also indicated the need for further health referrals, maternity interviews, neurodevelopmental assessments and generally additional community engagement. De Aar Solar Power, who announced their funding for FARR to expand their reach into Britstown, late last year, have been amazed that so much has already been successfully achieved, despite the severe pressure that called for creative thinking to continue to deliver on the programmes objectives given the COVID-19 restrictions. "It will probably get even more challenging, however, we believe that we will reach our targets as this is a project that is addressing the needs of the community and it enjoys the support of the relevant stakeholders," said Leana Olivier, CEO of FARR.

The community survey, conducted earlier in the year, included a study to confirm the prevalence of FAS and related diseases, a Healthy Mother Healthy Baby programme, as well as Anthropometric Screening and medical examination. "One of the key training sessions, that included both intense theoretical and practical training, had to be converted to distance education training, which was a massive undertaking as we had to video record the theoretical input, compile workbooks for the staff and do video recordings of interviews, due to the national lockdown period," explained Olivier, demonstrating one of the ways in which adaptation has been required. "We are very pleased that this vital work hasn't been halted during the pandemic, as FAS is a crippling, yet preventable form of mental illness, with a significant percentage coming from the communities in and around De Aar, and we

suspect Britstown may be equally impacted," explained Harrisinah Theka, Economic Development Officer at De Aar Solar Power.

FARR set up local offices in Britstown so that it can service the community properly, by providing community support, especially to expectant mothers and young children. FARR is a leading NGO source of research and information on Fetal Alcohol Spectrum Disorders (FASD) and the most severe form of this disorder, namely Fetal Alcohol Syndrome (FAS), in South Africa. The organisation is dedicated to building positive futures in South African communities by significantly reducing birth defects and mental disabilities caused by alcohol consumption during pregnancy.

"We have previously supported FARR in the community of De Aar and are now helping the NGO expand its work into new communities," said Harrisinah Theka, Economic Development Manager for De Aar Solar Power.

FARR has become a hub for experts, community workers and everyday South Africans who are determined to improve the lives of those affected by FAS, their families and caregivers. They are involved in training, education, research, prevention, support and management projects across South Africa. "We believe that FARR has an important role to play in rural communities across our country, such as the small town of Britstown in the heart of the Central Karoo," concluded Harrisinah.

BRANDSTOFPRYSE STYG WEER SKERP

BRANDSTOFPRYSE het Woensdag vir die tweede agtereenvolgende maand aansienlik styg. Die prys van 93-oktaan-petrol het met R1,63 per liter gestyg terwyl 95-oktaan-petrol met R1,72 per liter gestyg het. Diesel met 'n swaelinhoud van 0,05% het met R1,73 per liter gestyg en diesel met 'n swaelinhoud van 0,005% het met R1,69 per liter gestyg. Paraffien is R2,14 duurder per liter terwyl gas met R4,48 per kilogram duurder is.

Volgens die departement is die hoofredes vir die styging weens die rand-dollar-wisselkoers en die styging in oliepryse en petroleumprodukte. Die Automobiël-Assosiasie (AA) het vroeër gesê die rand het in Junie ongeveer 34 sent teenoor die Amerikaanse dollar versterk, hoewel die plaaslike geldeenheid steeds sowat R2,50 swakker teenoor die dollar is as voor die Covid-19-pandemie en die land se kredietafgradering. "Ons kan nie oorbeklemtoon watter invloed die ineenstorting van die rand tans op brandstofverbruikers het nie. Indien die rand gebly het op die vlak wat dit was voor die Covid-19-pandemie, sou brandstofverbruikers waarskynlik volgende maand 'n daling van 75 sent per liter in brandstofpryse gesien het," het die AA gesê.

Die petrolprys het begin Junie met R1,18 per liter gestyg, terwyl die prys van diesel met tussen 21c en 22c per liter gestyg het. Paraffien het met tussen 40c en 54c gestyg en gas met R1,98.
